- A track record of successful projects with client reviews and references.

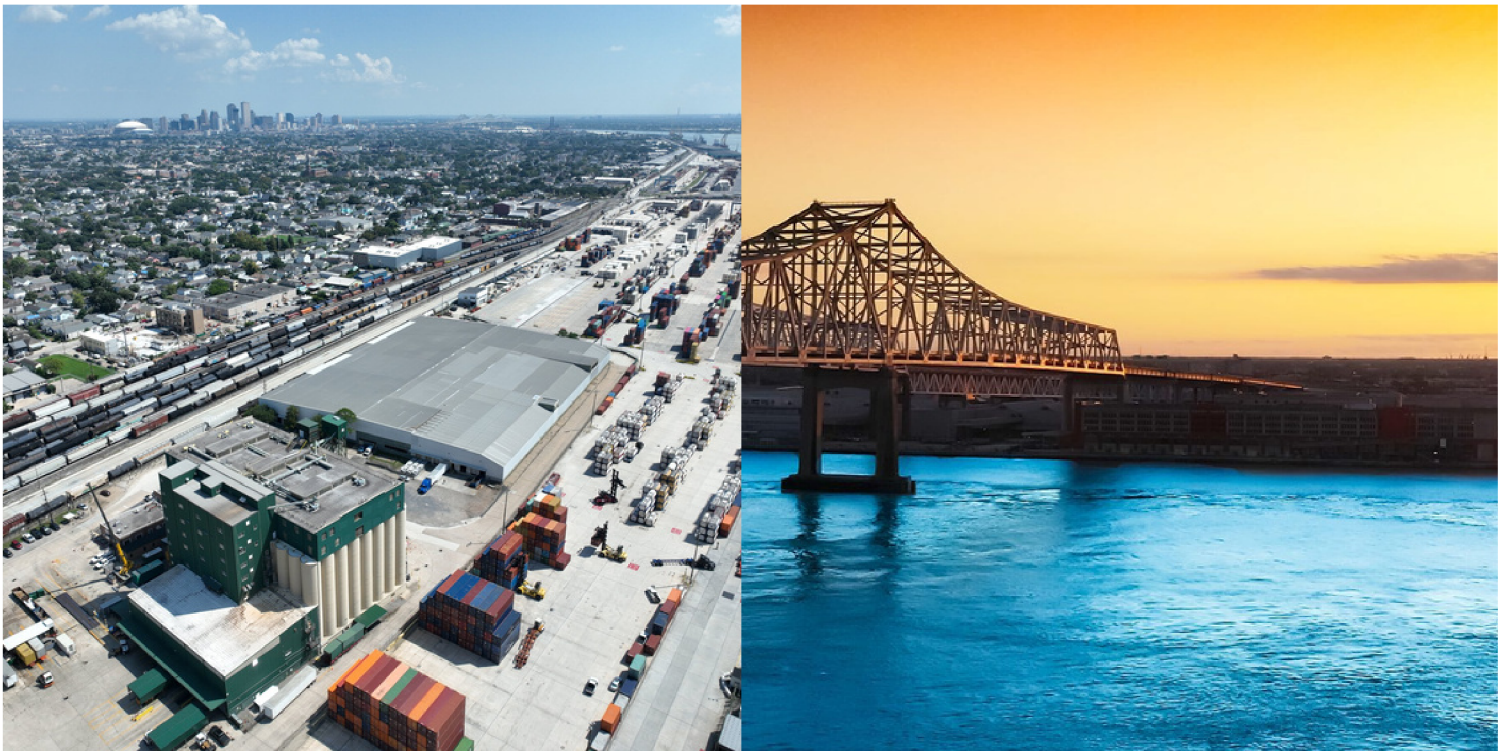




Review Portfolios:

Examine the provider's portfolio to assess the quality and diversity of their work.

- Look for examples of projects similar to yours to gauge their expertise.
- If you don't see anything related to your project, ask them if they have something else to show. Most drone companies only post a small fraction of their finished work online.





Contact and Discuss:

- Reach out to providers to discuss your project.
- Share your requirements, budget, and project timeline.
- Inquire about their equipment, safety protocols and procedures.



Request Quotes:

- Request detailed quotes from each provider, including a breakdown of costs.
- Ensure the quotes cover all aspects of the project, including equipment, labor, travel, and post-production.





Check References:

- Request references from the provider and contact previous clients.
- Ask references about their satisfaction with the provider's work, professionalism, and adherence to deadlines.



Confirm Licensing and Insurance:

- Confirm that the drone service provider holds the necessary licenses to operate legally.
- Verify their liability insurance to protect against accidents or damages during the project.
